

Emergency Preparedness Proposals

Notice is hereby given that the Town of Fairland will receive bid proposals for the purpose of negotiating an emergency maintenance contract for the year 2014, up to and until the hour of 6:00 p.m. (EST) on November 25, 2013 and which proposals shall be considered at a meeting of the Town Council on Tuesday, December 3, 2013 at 6:00 p.m. Proposals may be submitted by U.S. First Class Mail to P.O. Box 150, Fairland, IN 46126, or emailed to contactus@fairlandin.org. The proposals received for the emergency maintenance contract shall be negotiated, denied, or awarded by the Town Board of the Town of Fairland.

Bids should include hourly rates for services including, but not limited to debris removal such as fall trees, or other road obstructions, structure repair, temporary road repair, sign placement for road closures, etc.

After careful tabulation, consideration and negotiation on the bid proposals received, a contract for emergency maintenance shall be awarded to the bidder from whom the Town Board determines it has received the lowest and best responsible negotiated bid.

The Town Board of the Town of Fairland reserves the right to reject any or all bids and proposals, to discuss with responsible officers who submit proposals determined to be reasonably susceptible of being selected, and to determine which seems to be the best bid. The successful proposal will be required to furnish adequate proof of insurance
