

The Fairland Town Council met for a regular monthly on Tuesday, May 5, 2009, at 6:00 P.M. The meeting was held in the Fairland Volunteer Fire Department located at 106 S. Walnut St., Fairland, Indiana.

The following board members were present: Richard Daily, John Hansen and Jeremy Creech.

Also present was Christine Brinson, Clerk-Treasurer, and John Merlau, Town Attorney.

President, Richard Daily, called the meeting to order at 6:02 p.m.

ROUTINE BUSINESS:

Minutes of the 4/7/09 meeting were considered. John Hanson made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Jeremy Creech seconded the motion. Motion passed by a vote of 3-0.

OLD BUSINESS:

President Daily reported that the bill on which the amendment was attached to commence funding for the Town earlier than April 1, 2009 was the budget bill which failed to pass.

President Daily reported the Commissioners approved giving the Town \$25,000.00 for completing a sewer study, it is to go before the County Council on 5/19/09.

Treasurer requested to place on the agenda for the June meeting, grant writer and Indianapolis Water Company.

President Daily reported that he had a meeting with a representative of the Census Bureau.

Treasurer commented on the chuck holes in the town roads. President Daily advised that he already had a call into the County Commissioners regarding the same. Discussion ensued regarding the condition of the railroad track crossings and issues with CSX and Phase 1 of the Transportation Plan.

NEW BUSINESS:

Treasurer Brinson advised she had been notified that Mike Rund had been called out of town and therefore, the Fairland Fire Department request to be on the agenda was being moved until the June meeting.

Council members discussed having a booth at the Fairland Fish Fry to garner resident's input and give out information regarding the census, and answer resident's questions. A possible survey of residents was discussed.


There being no more new business, President Daily opened the meeting for public comments.

Keith Fisher mentioned there is a great lack of information in the northern part of the County regarding the activities of the County officials and the officials of the City of Shelbyville, due in part to residents close proximity to Indianapolis; their not subscribing to the local newspaper, and possibly not having internet access. He is looking at ways to help disseminate the local news and issues to the county's northern residents. He suggested that the Town Council make an appearance at Heritage Days in Pleasant View.
